

RE-GATHERING GUIDELINES

Please remain home if any of the following apply:

- You are experiencing any symptoms such as fever (100.0 and above) or chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, fatigue, headache, muscle/body aches, runny nose/congestion, new loss of taste or smell, or nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- You have had "close contact" with an individual diagnosed with COVID-19. "Close contact" means living in the same household as a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, caring for a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, being within 6 feet of a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 for 15 minutes or more, or coming in direct contact with secretions (e.g., sharing utensils, being coughed on) from a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, while that person was symptomatic
- You have been asked to self-isolate or quarantine by your doctor or a local public health official.
- You are particularly vulnerable to COVID-19 according to the Centers for Disease Control (e.g., due to age or underlying conditions).

Should you choose to attend on-site worship:

- You will be required to wear a mask that covers both your mouth and your nose. No exceptions. You may be asked to have your temperature taken as you arrive at church, although we do not anticipate this to be a regular practice. If you are unable to wear a mask, our service is live-streamed on FaceBook and is available on YouTube and Cable TV.
- Proper Social Distancing (6 feet) must be maintained at all times. Please do not congregate before or after the service. This will be a challenge as we are a social community!
- You must arrive between 9:30 AM and 9:45 AM in order to be seated. Those arriving late will not be able to be accommodated as we need extra time to give the assembly directions prior to starting. The usher will assign you a seat.
- Communal singing is not allowed. Singing has been shown to be a high-risk activity.
- Communion will be shared. Those gathered will have the opportunity to receive communion in one kind- the bread only. The cup will not be shared. You will come forward in a single communion "station." The process will be explained prior to the beginning of the service.
- You will be asked to stay through the conclusion of the Postlude. The ushers will direct the assembly in departing at the conclusion of the recording. Early departures should be for emergencies only.
- You may appear in our livestream-broadcast of the Eucharist.
